This position will be responsible for developing, estimating, implementing, and managing capital projects for MarkWest Liberty. Develops and adheres to project budgets. You will provide technical support, leadership, and oversight to all facility project activities. Performs all work in compliance with company standards, procedures, and government requirements. This position will primarily be responsible for projects related to natural gas compression and gathering.

As a team member, this person will also assist in other Operations, Engineering, Commercial, Maintenance, and EH&S related activities.

### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Perform project cost estimating and generation of AFE’s for the Liberty Business Unit.
- Manage projects of varying magnitude and complexity.
- Develop and adhere to complex schedules encompassing multiple projects pipeline and compression projects.
- Develop and adhere to project budgets and have ability to implement cost controls and cost reductions as required.

- Develop EPC bid packages and contracts.
- Evaluate bids and proposals, and be able to identify and nominate preferred contractor based on both short-term and long-term MarkWest objectives.
- Manage multiple EPC contractors during design, engineering, and construction phase of projects.
- Maintain knowledge and ability to apply engineering standards as they relate to MarkWest facilities.
- Maintain expertise in compressor station design, regulations and requirements.
- Maintain accurate knowledge of electrical power systems, motor control systems, and electrical switchgear.
- Maintain expertise in pipeline design, specifications, regulations and requirements.
- Interface with all applicable government and industry regulatory agencies.
- Provide equipment specifications per MarkWest standards.
- Maintain accurate knowledge of compressors, compressor stations, and pipeline systems and associated processing equipment.
