Responsible for developing, estimating, implementing, and managing capital projects for MarkWest. Develops and adheres to project budgets. You will provide technical support, leadership, and oversight to MarkWest project activities. Performs all work in compliance with company standards, procedures, and government requirements. You will supervise staff of project engineers.

As a team member, this person will also assist in other Operations, Engineering, Commercial, Maintenance, and EH&S related activities.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform project cost estimating and generation of AFE’s for MarkWest.
- Manage projects of varying magnitude and complexity.
- Supervises, develops and mentors staff engineers.
- Develop and adhere to complex schedules encompassing multiple projects.
- Develop and adhere to project budgets and have ability to implement cost controls and cost reductions as required.

- Develop EPC bid packages and contracts.
- Evaluate bids and proposals, and be able to identify and nominate preferred contractor based on both short-term and long-term MarkWest objectives.
- Manage multiple EPC contractors during design, engineering, and construction phase of projects.
- Maintain knowledge and ability to apply engineering standards as they relate to MarkWest facilities.
- Maintain accurate working knowledge of gas plant processes and operations.
- Maintain accurate knowledge of electrical power systems, motor control systems, and electrical switchgear.
- Provide equipment specifications per MarkWest standards.
- Maintain accurate knowledge of rotating equipment, pressure vessels, boilers, gas-fired heaters, pipeline systems and associated processing equipment.
