In general, this position will perform any mechanical and maintenance issues related to MarkWest, Western or Eastern Oklahoma. These duties will include system operations and compressor maintenance on a daily and as needed basis.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Compressor repair.
- Compressor maintenance.
- Compressor overhauls.
- Pump installation or repair.
- Pipeline operations.
- Pipeline locating.
- Pipeline pigging.
- Daily compressor operations.

- Maintaining clean and safe compressor locations.
- Maintaining scheduled preventative maintenance programs.
- Maintaining daily compressor reports.
- Ordering compressor parts as needed.
- Maintaining accurate condensate records as needed.
- Managing condensate levels at any or all compressor stations in his area.
- Comply with MarkWest Safety rules.
- Reporting and repairing if applicable, any unsafe condition or situation that would compromise the integrity of any MWWOK employees, equipment or locations.
- Making any or all repairs as deemed reasonable and safe to do.
- Maintaining the company issued vehicle at all times to ensure safety.
- Maintaining the tools and equipment issued to him.
- Take call on a regular basis.
- Work weekends on a rotating basis “if needed”.
