As a member of the Oracle/Hyperion team, the Senior Hyperion Analyst will be responsible for all Hyperion applications. This will include ESSBase, Financial Data Quality Management and SmartView. They will serve as a liaison between the financial users and IT assisting in the development, design, and implementation of the Hyperion Financial Reporting Applications as well as ongoing maintenance and application assistance.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Day-to-day administration and maintenance of the Hyperion applications
- Responsible for coordinating with the team to maintain reports in Hyperion System 9+ IR, complete development of new reports using client driven requirements and respond to client and auditor requests for ad hoc reports
- Modify/Enhance ESSBase cubes as well as Import/load data into Essbase to support financial reporting

- Gather business requirements and assist with the implementation of technical solutions including, design, development, testing, deployment, and end user training for the internal financial reporting systems (Essbase & FDM)
- Troubleshoot any report-related issues
- Act as an integral member of the general accounting team
